Estimated need of 90 total cabins on board ship. RCCL will only allow a hold of 50 cabins until group starts to sell. More cabins can be added after deposits have been made on 50% of original block.

Initial block of 50 cabins includes:

- 7 Balcony cabins
- 21 Outside cabins
- 10 Inside cabins with view of the Promenade interior of the ship
- 8 Inside cabins

Additional cabins will be held as one sells – another will be added until reaching our projected 90.

\$2300 initial deposit is due to Royal Caribbean by October 7, 2011.

RCCL will allow one free berth for every 16. Free berths do not include taxes nor port fees and fuel fees imposed by RCCL. Free berths will be utilized to compensate AAA for services listed above, less 2 free for Dr and Mrs Sidharta. Number of free berths are dependent on the number of berths sold to group. AAA will limit their service staff need to 6 free berths unless other services are requested requiring more staff.

Additional compensation in the form of funds per stateroom can be applied to the ship board accounts of passengers or applied to cost of a gathering on board ship during days at sea. The funds, however, cannot be deducted from the final payment of passengers. Passenger account to be paid as quoted – any reimbursements would be after the sailing and dependent on the total number of paid berths.
